

## Users in Digital Access

The information gathered on these pages can be found under the **Manage Accounts and Storage** tab in the [Smart ID Digital Access component](#) administration interface.

A user is a known registered identity that is unique in Digital Access component. A user can request access to a [resource](#) or get a ticket ([SAML](#)) for access to other systems.

To control what [resources](#) a user can access, a [user account](#) is needed in the Digital Access component. The user accounts can be linked to user information already stored in your company's directory service (for example, Microsoft's Active Directory). By combining [user accounts](#), [user groups](#), [user storage](#) and identity management, you control which users access what applications and how.
